

Double Punched Blossom (thanks to Julie Davidson for her original tutorial)



Stamp Sets: Mixed Bunch, Teeny Tiny Wishes

Ink: Riding Hood Red, Baja Breeze

Paper:

Whisper White 4"x 12" for card base

2 3/4" x 2 3/4" for punched flower

Scraps for flower center and greeting

Riding Hood Red: scraps

Twitterpated Designer Series Paper (2) 2"x 4"

Accessories: Simply Scoring tool, Blossom, 1" circle, Word Window and Modern Label punches, rhinestone, Sharpie, Dimensionals, Glue Stick



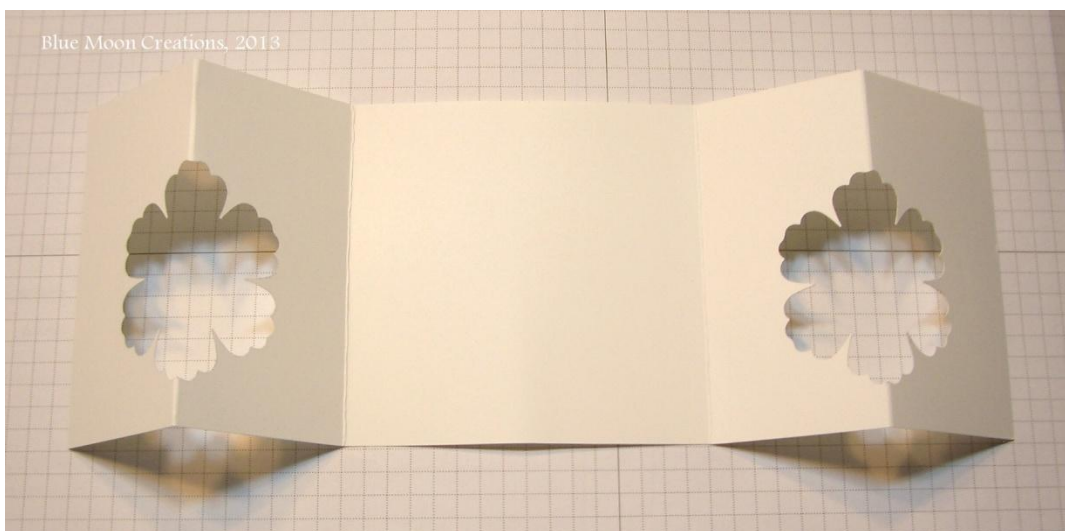


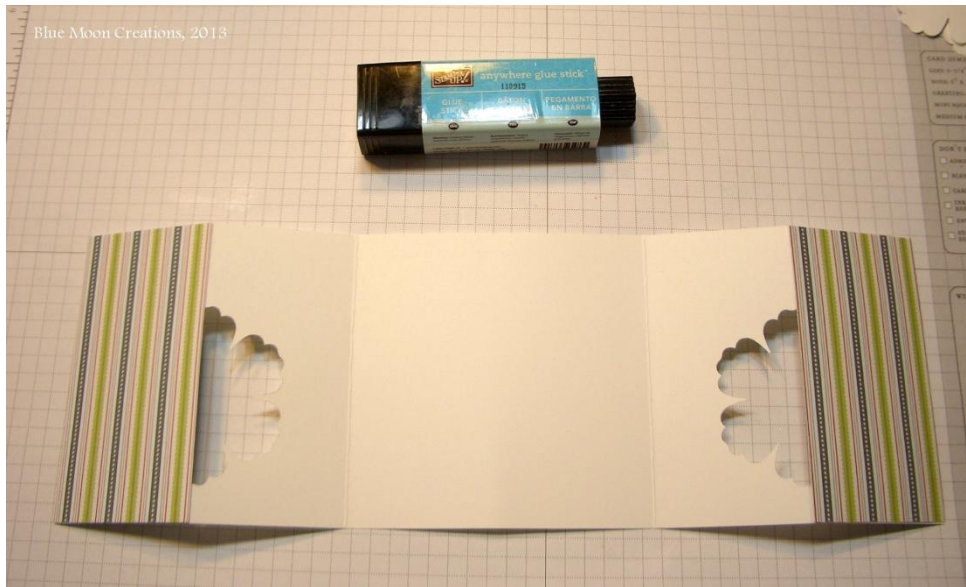
1. Start with a piece of Whisper White card stock measuring 4"x 12". Score at 2", 4", 8" and 10".



2. Hold the ends of the Whisper White cardstock together (without folding or creasing the middle) and punch through both layers together using the Blossom punch. Put the punch all the way in, centering on the score line.

TIP: It will be easier to punch if you lay the punch flat on the table. You can still use it upside down to see where you are punching, but place the top of the punch flat on the table.





3. Use SNAIL Adhesive or Glue Stick to adhere 2-2"x4" Designer Series Paper on each end of the Whisper White card stock. The DSP should come right up against the score line.

TIP: Use a Glue Stick to get into all the edges of the punched flower.



4. Use the Blossom punch to line up and punch through the DSP on both ends. TIP: Line the punch up on the back side so you can see what you are doing.

5. Stamp the flower from Mixed Bunch using Riding Hood Red ink on a piece of Whisper White card stock. Punch out using the Blossom Punch.

6. Stamp the flower center in Baja Breeze ink on Whisper White card stock and punch out using the 1" Circle punch.

7. Adhere the circle the center of the flower. Add a rhinestone in the center and color with a Sharpie if desired.

8. Fold the card on the score lines. The center folds are "valley" folds. The two end folds are "mountain" folds.

9. Line up the punched flower to the front of the card and adhere to the inside of the card using Dimensionals. Open the card. The first time you open the card, it may get caught up on the flower. That's okay, just gently adjust the flower.

10. Stamp a greeting using Teeny Tiny Wishes in Baja Breeze ink on a piece of scrap Whisper White. Punch out using the Word Window punch. Punch a mat piece out of scrap Riding Hood Red card stock using the Modern Label punch. Layer two pieces.

11. Put adhesive on half of the back and adhere it to one flap of the card. Make sure to only glue down one half of the greeting or the card will be glued shut!
